Craft Badge

Introduction:

Craft is the simplified name for "Art and Craft". It refers to the process of labour turning raw materials or semi-finished works into finished works through value-added processing or treatment by production tools. It also refers to daily necessities, ornaments which contain aesthetic factor and have undergone arts processes in external format. This badge aims at cultivating our Brigaders' minds and unleash their potential in studying specialized technique.

Assessment criteria

Notes

- 1. Art Badge, Craft Badge, Hobbies Badge can be examined at the same time. However, if the Brigader have completed his chosen items in Craft Badge, he cannot choose the same item in Art Badge, Hobbies Badge. Another new item should be chosen.
- 2. The same item or another item can be chosen in Stage 2, 3 of Craft Badge.
- 3. The Brigader should show his work record, attendance or training certificate when he is applying for this badge. Competition certificate is not counted for proving his attendance for
