The first seed was planted by some mission-minded BB Singapore personnel as early as in 1994. However, the ministry was suspended in 1997 and again in 2000 due to the political unrest in the country.

It was not until 2002, the idea of re-establishing a presence in Cambodia was re-visited when BB Singapore started to send teams to connect with the local Cambodian Christians.

Subsequently a piece of land in Siem Reap was purchased by BB Singapore and a building was put up in 2005 thus signaling the intent of BB to establish a permanent presence in Cambodia.

The place called BB Learning Centre or in short BBLC was

set up to provide English and IT tuition to the local youths. Nevertheless, BBLC was established as a promotional vehicle to further the BB agenda in the country.

Since then many BB companies espe-

cially from Malaysia and Singapore has visited the country for community work and such activities help to promote the the BB presence among the churches, community and particularly the Cambodian government.



Contact was made immediately in January 2010 with two (2) Christian schools namely, MGC Newlife Christian Academy and Grace Christian College in Manila after The Boys' & Girls' Brigade, Philippines discontinued their associate membership on November 1, 2009.

On January 22, 2010, the first BB orientation seminar was conducted at Grace Christian College in Manila. The half day seminar was attended by 35 participants from various churches and Christian schools in Luzon island.

This led to more orientation seminars when news were spread by those who have attended the earlier seminars. By the end of

2010, five (5) new BB companies were formed. Officers trainings were also conducted to equip BB officers to run BB programs.

A further ten (10) more new companies were born in 2011 with a total membership of 1500 Boys and Girls.



Regional Extension - The Philippines



One of the major milestone achieved in 2011 was the recruitment of 500 street and homeless Boys and Girls. They were recruited in January 2011 and was enrolled in April 2011. Lives were transformed and today

nies to sponsor some poor rural aboriginal BB companies in Thailand, Malaysia, the Philippines, to buy uniform accessories and badges.

BB Asia also launched the BB International Voluntary Service (IVP) Program in 2011. The program brought together BB mem-

bers from different culture and nationalities together for spiritual,


social and cultural learning experiences.






Membership growth of BB Asia over the last 7 years was on a steady growth path except in 2009, when membership declined by 7%. *This was due to the withdrawal of The Boys' & Girls' Brigade Philippines in November 2009. Thus, BB Asia membership had an annual increased of 5% per annum over a 6 years period.
