

# Art Badge

Introduction: The origin of 'Art' is from the Latin word-'Arts', which means techniques, including all imaginative and creative activities. Art can be categorized into different aspects, such as drawing, sculpture, architecture, literature, music, drama, dance, movie etc.

Aim: To cultivate Brigaders' minds and develop their interests in art.

## **Course Outline**

Brigaders must take part in the related activity continuously.

Suggested categories:

1. Art (For example: sketch, oil painting, watercolour painting, acrylic, sculpture, editing, traditional Chinese painting, calligraphy, coloured painting, ceramics etc.)
2. Literature (For example: script, prose, modern poetry, comics etc.)
3. Drama (For example: radio drama, stage play, pantomime, puppet play etc.)
4. Music (For example: music composition, music appreciation, singing etc.)
5. Dances (For example: traditional dance, modern dance, pop dance, international standard dance, folk dance, ballet etc.)
6. Photography (For example: composition, video production etc.)
7. Design (For example: three-dimensional design, graphic design etc.)

## **Assessment criteria**

1. Write a simple report including the difficulties encountered during the learning process, ways to solve the difficulties and the learning experience.
2. Present and introduce the works. Include a 5 - minute sharing for the presentation
3. PowerPoint, CDs or other media can be used for the presentation

## **Notes**

1. Art Badge, Craft Badge and Hobbies Badge can be examined at the same time. However, categories examined in the Art Badge should not be examined again. Another category should be chosen.
2. The same or a different category can be chosen in Stages 2 and 3 of Art Badge.
3. Any working record, proof of attendance or training certificate should be submitted for the application of this badge. Competition certificate is not counted for proving the attendance for the activity. If no related and appropriate documents are received, the badge should not be presented to the Brigaders.
